### **Old Business**

Capital projects update – photo screen installed (put any photos you want to display on a USB, in folders according to event e.g. VO tournament, and take up to court to install on club computer - Bal can help), display cases installed for VPTC use only – no outside flyers please, Bev and Karalee meeting with VP mgmt. Dec 6 – anything you want us to bring up, please email. Budget – only named person has access to funds.

**Handbook** – read it over, make sure you know what is expected e.g. in cases of rain **Medical info** – Harold Heyming has offered CCC training and will gladly come to a practice or gathering - please reach out to him at Unit 0418. First aid kit is now available at all times in the women's washroom.

**Ball machine review** – please remind all players – blue dot balls stay in the ball machine and for use with ball machine ONLY, non-members do not have access to the balls machine or carts of balls, don't book court 1/9 unless you plan to use the ball machine or no other court available. It is important to recycle tennis balls. The average time to recycle is after the third use.

**Volunteer needs** – Coordinators now in place for 2.0W (Louise Pyle), 2.5W (Deborah Lenover), 2.5M (Dave Romann will be asked), 3.0M (Steve Barron). Coordinators still needed for 3.5W and 4.0 M.

#### **New Business**

Orientation policy – Team Captain or Facilitator responsible for providing new members with a mentor to review the Basic Information List. Ask a member of your team to volunteer as a mentor to new members. Green Committee - Deedee Asmundson will organize the collection of aluminum pop lids from tennis ball containers for charity. A bin will be set up next to the recycle ball containers.

Emphasis on "going green" - encourage reusable plates, cups, utensils at all Club events.

#### **Committee Reports**

**Recognition** – Wendy Dyck will be coming around in January with nomination forms. Presentations will be held at a social event prior to March 4 general meeting.

**Tenniscores** – Jae/Bonita. Question was asked: If a captain doesn't enter scores, can it be corrected after the fact and the answer is yes. Contact Bonita who will reach out to the person who can do that. Question was asked: How can we make sure that matches are even? Captains should work together. That's all we can do now. This issue needs to be worked out through EVSTL as the season progresses.

**Coaching** – Terry Butler – Doing lot of evaluations and re-evaluations, if more coaching is needed, Terry will find more help.

**New member recruitment** – Enzo – Tennis Mind Game event is for members, but may want to roll out to community as a fun, entertaining and educational event for recruiting new members. Ladies 3.5 team is leading team recruitment challenge with 5 paid new members.
